MEMORIAL GARDEN – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Any memorial plaque space will be leased for a period of ten years from the date the plaque is fixed.

The Central Durham Crematorium Joint Committee will maintain the memorial garden and keep it tidy.

The Joint Committee will maintain and periodically clean the memorial plaque.

The Joint Committee will not allow plastic, silk or any other artificial flowers or pot plants in the memorial garden, and reserve the right to remove any such items and dispose of them.

The Joint Committee reserve the right to remove dead or dying flowers from the memorial garden, at the discretion of the Registrar.

The applicant for the lease should inform the Joint Committee of any change of address or, in the case of the death of the applicant, the Joint Committee should be advised and this lease assigned.

Before the expiry of the lease period, a renewal invitation will be forwarded to the person who made the application for the lease of the memorial, or to such person to whom the lease has been assigned. If the lease is not renewed within the given time scale, the Crematorium Joint Committee will remove the plaque and dispose of it in any way it deems appropriate.
